All Hands on Deck is the next sailing innovation program of Sail for the Future Foundation. For 5 days, teams of company representatives and young thinkers will solve sustainability challenges of those companies while sailing. At the end of this 5 day-hackathon, the company representatives take the solutions from this hackathon back to their companies where they start implementing them during an implementation phase of 6 months. During this period, the team of young thinkers functions as an external advisory board to the company representatives. After the 6 month implementation phase, the results of the All hands on Deck program will be presented publicly at the same time of COP27.

WHAT YOU GET

- A chance to develop yourself as a person and a professional. We will thereby allow you to focus on things you want to learn. We aim at creating an environment in which we actively reflect on that learning process,
- Possibly the chance to join on board of one of the ships during the event (to be discussed within the project team and depending on the number of company teams participating),
- The freedom to organize your way of working as you want, in consultation with your team members,
- You become part of Sail for the Future Foundation, a group of motivated volunteers, both students and young professionals. You will be invited to take part in the (team building) activities of Sail for the Future Foundation.

WHAT YOU WILL DO

As a project team member you will help set up the program. The Sail for the Future team has designed a framework for the program, which offers a starting point. It is yours as a project team to give the program your touch. More specifically are we looking for the following team members:

- Project leader

As a project leader, you keep the overview of all activities happening concerning the program. You make sure that the activities of all team members are aligned and that timings are respected in order to make the program a success. You will be the main internal contact person for this program. You will function in close collaboration with the board of Sail for the Future.

- Logistics (2 positions)

As logistics team members, you are responsible for everything that has to do with operations and logistics. This includes arranging locations to run the program, you could expect having to arrange sailing vessels, locations to start and end the program, etc. During the program you are the one having full control of all practical stuff. You know who has to be where and when.

- Marketing and Communication

As the marketing and communications team member, you are responsible for the communication campaign concerning the program. This includes setting up a communication campaign for on social media for before, during and after the event. It could also include designing communication tools to support the other team members.

- Finances

As the team member responsible for finances, you take care of the finances of the whole program. This includes drawing the budget, doing payments where needed and sending out invoices. As an optional addition to this, you could also decide to be involved in the acquisition of companies for the program.

- Program coordinator (2 positions)

As a program coordinator, you are responsible for the content of the innovation program. The Sail for the Future team has designed the framework for the program, it is yours as a project team to give the program your touch. More specifically will you:

- contact and invite inspirational speakers of your choice
- design the specific sessions of the innovation program, you will be in touch with our innovation and personal development partners to do so
